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BACKGROUND

Bharatpur Eye Hospital is located in Chitwan district of southern central Nepal, is a non-profit charitable organization, providing high quality comprehensive eye care services at affordable cost to local as well as patients from neighboring districts; Gorkha, Lamjung, Nawalparasi, Tanahu, Makawanpur, Parsa & Dhading comprising of about two million populations. In addition to Base Hospital, BEH has established several eye care centres in different locations to provide basic eye care facility to the community. BEH currently has following networks of eye care centres in under mentioned locations.

The hospital, named after Late His Majesty King Mahendra Bir Bikram Shah Dev, is located in the delightful city of Bharatpur, the capital of Chitwan district, by the bank of Narayani River, a place of pilgrimage of the Hindus. The hospital ranks first among the eye hospitals in Nepal. It has an area of four Bighas, three-fourths of which is occupied by the hospital building itself, and the remainder is cultivated as forestland.

Bharatpur Eye Hospital was established in 1987 under the aegis of Nepal Netra Jyoti Sangh (NNJS-National Society for Comprehensive Eye Care Service). The hospital building was constructed with financial and technical support from BCCI foundation Pakistan. Initially, it was established to provide eye care services in Chitwan district only but in the pursuit of growth and expansion with the support from various international organizations, relentless efforts and commitment put in, by its staff members and continued cooperation from local community, have made it possible for BEH to serve beyond Chitwan.

The hospital was constructed with the grant assistance from the Bank of Commerce and Credit International (BCCI), Pakistan and the contribution made by His Excellency Mr. Gulam Ishaq Khan, who was then the President of Pakistan. The hospital building was formally inaugurated by the Late His Majesty King Birendra Bir Bikram Shah Dev on March 31, 1988 in the presence of Late Her Majesty Queen Aishwarya and the President of Pakistan.

There is only one eye hospital known as King Mahendra Memorial Eye Hospital (KMMEH), recently renamed as Bharatpur Eye Hospital, in Bharatpur apart from recently developed eye department of the teaching hospital. (Medical Colleges, there are two Private medical colleges, which are having small eye department just to fulfill the requirement of the medical college). The adjunct districts of Chitwan are Dhading, Gorkha, Makawanpur, Lamjung, Tanahu, Parsa and Nawalparasi. All these districts are the catchments areas of Bharatpur Eye Hospital Chitwan. Total population of these catchments area is about 1.5 millions.

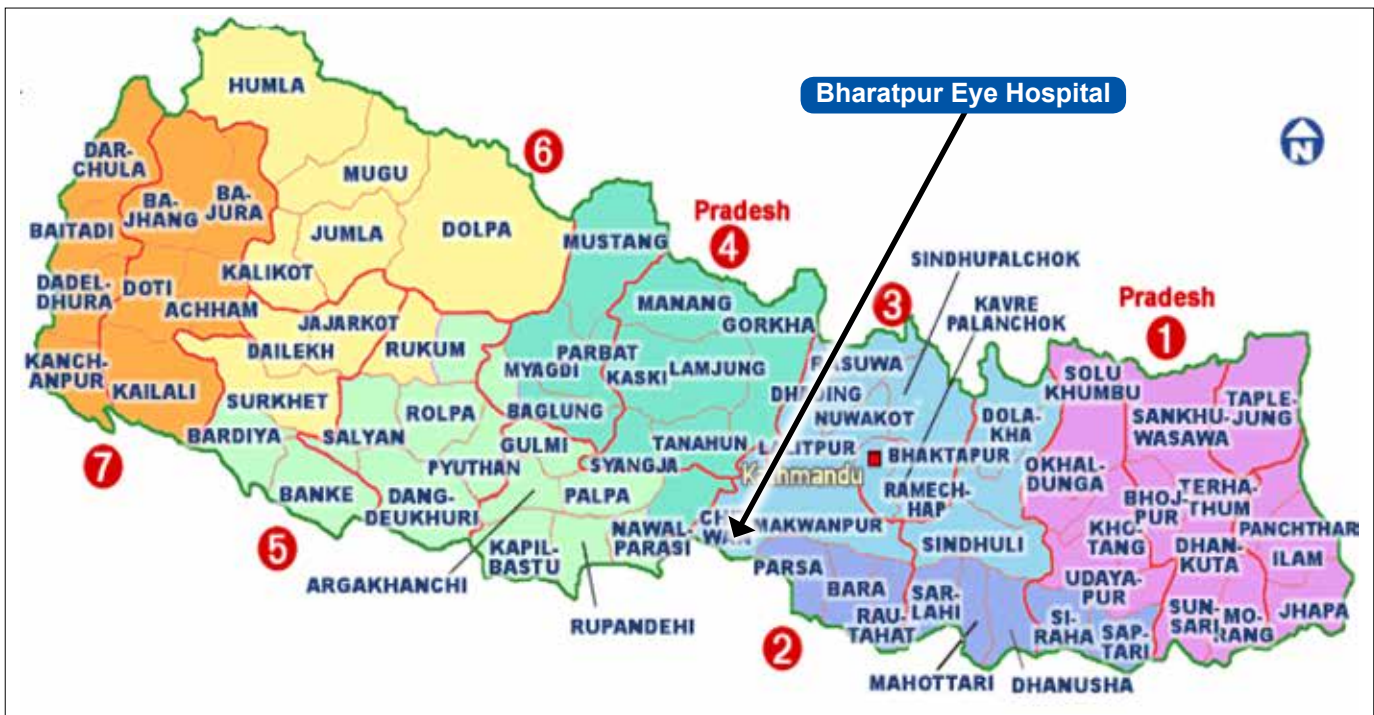

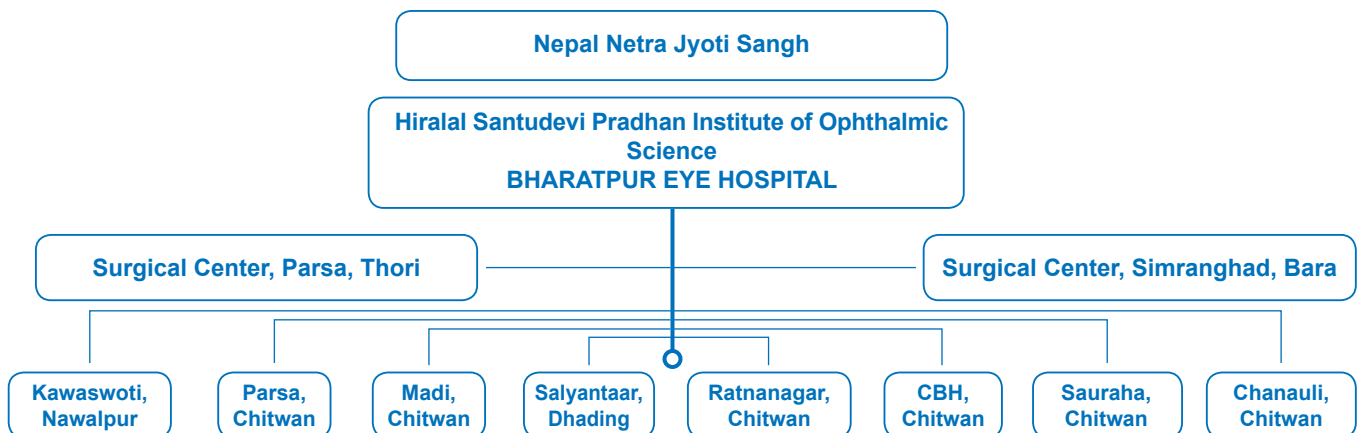

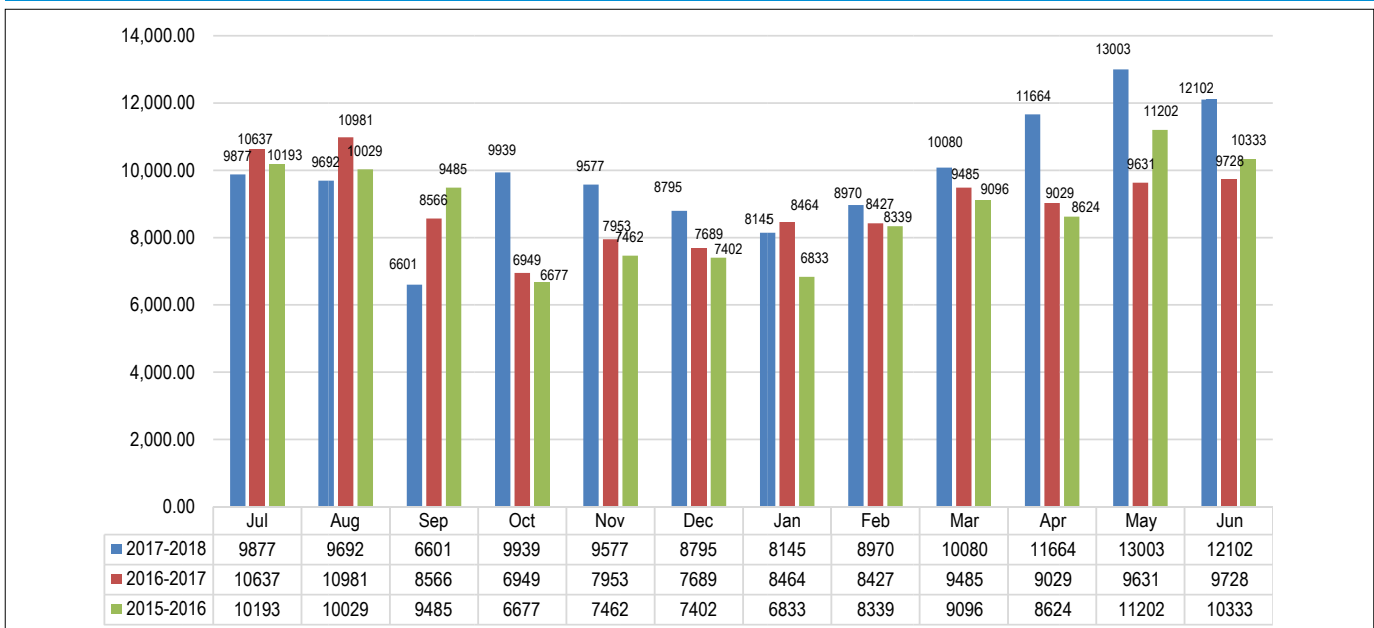

Gender Wise Distribution of OPD Patients

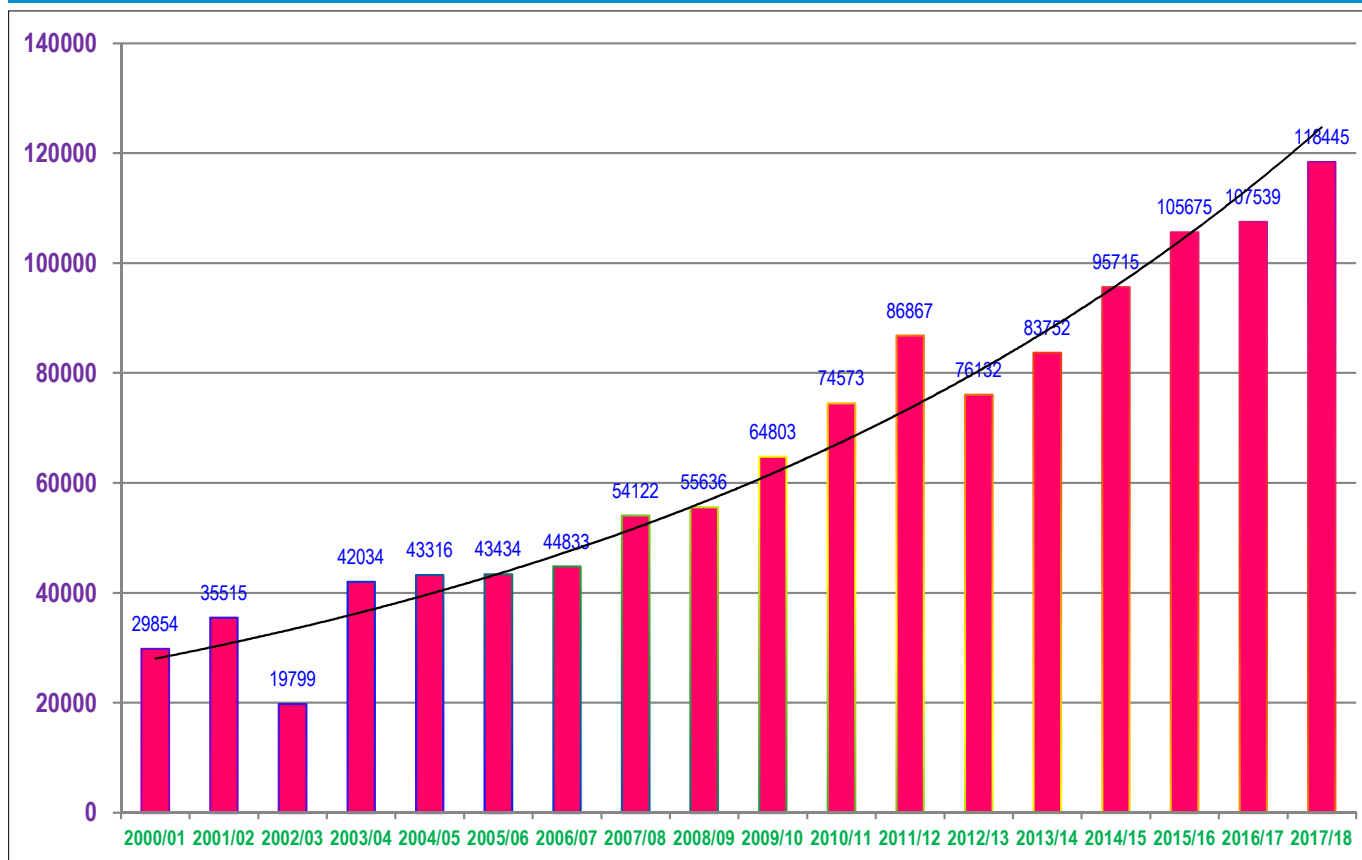

HOSPITAL PERFORMANCE SINCE 2000 AD



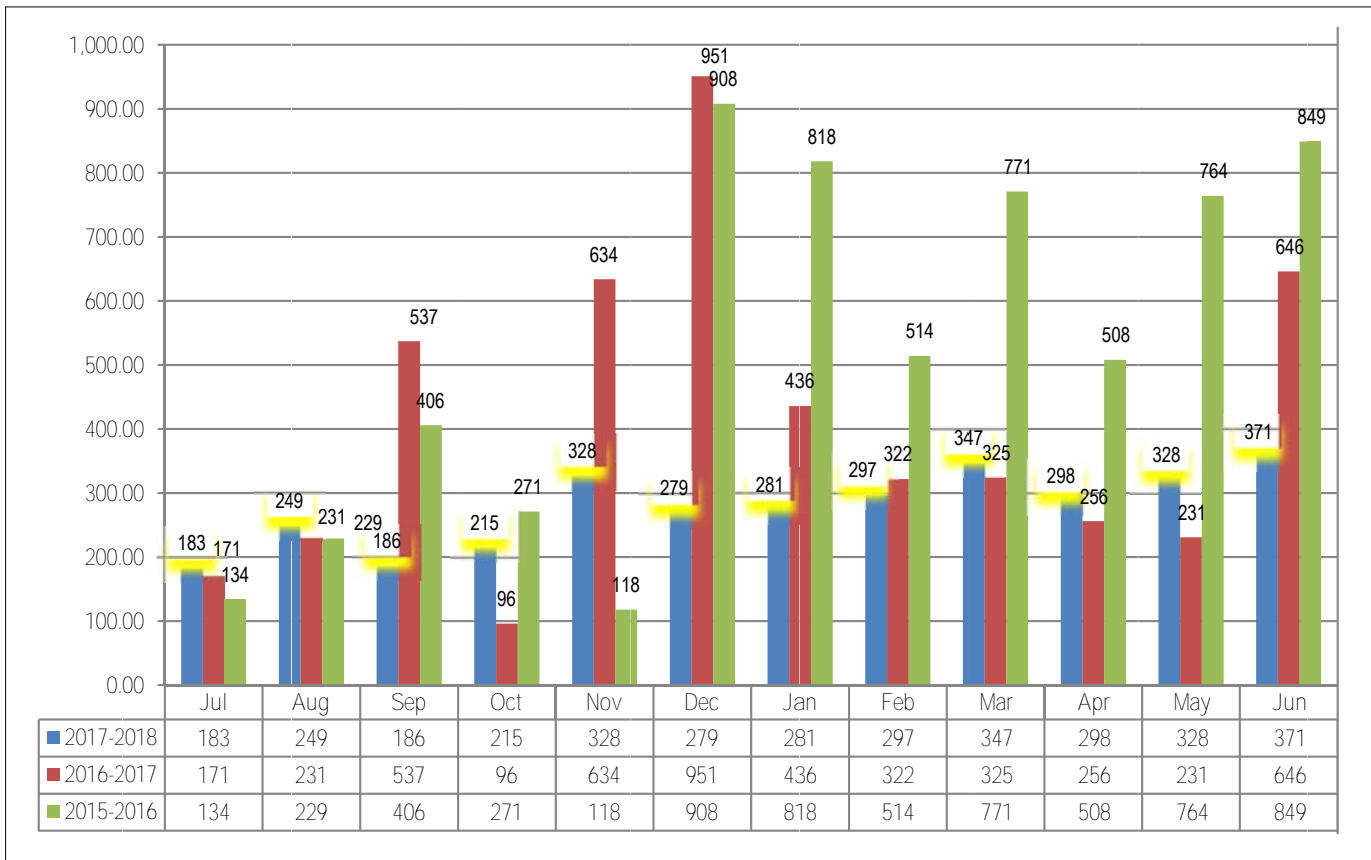
OCULAR SURGERIES 2017/18

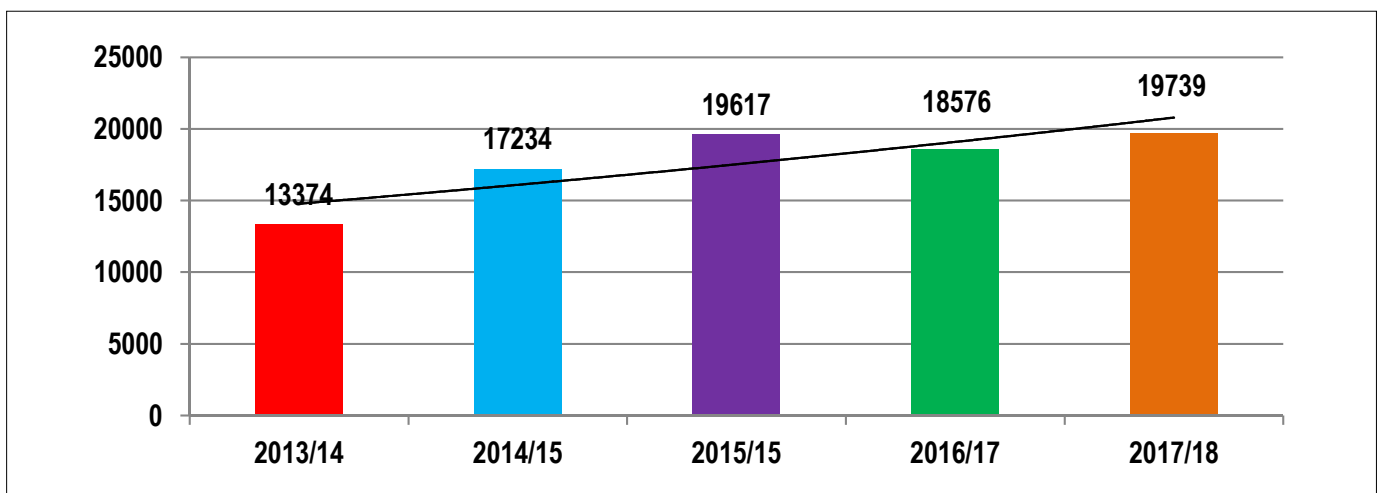
SPECIALITY & SUB-SPECIALITY SERVICES

Pediatric Ophthalmology Service:

The pediatric ophthalmology service has been upgraded in recent years with the provision of separate department well equipped with all the necessary instruments and treatment facilities. Ophthalmologists, optometrists and orthoptists work together to provide quality service to the patients. In FY 2017-2018 a total of 19,739 children were provided out patient's service of which 34 children underwent cataract surgeries and squint surgery was performed in 15 children. The number of pediatric surgeries is gradually in increasing trend with the introduction of general anesthesia facilities in the hospital.

Cornea Service:

In FY 2017-2018 total OPD patient were 2,696; out of total cornea outpatients 492 patients with corneal ulcer received their treatment. This hospital has a separate cornea department with cornea specialist. Ophthalmologist has been trained from Aravind Eye Care System, Madurai, India. We have started Cornea transplant and cornea collection center in this hospital.

Since the introduction of corneal transplant service at the hospital a total of 52 patients underwent their corneal transplants those include both therapeutic and optical purpose. Since the establishment of the cornea collection center 8 corneas have been collected so far.

Post-Operative (After Cornea Transplant)



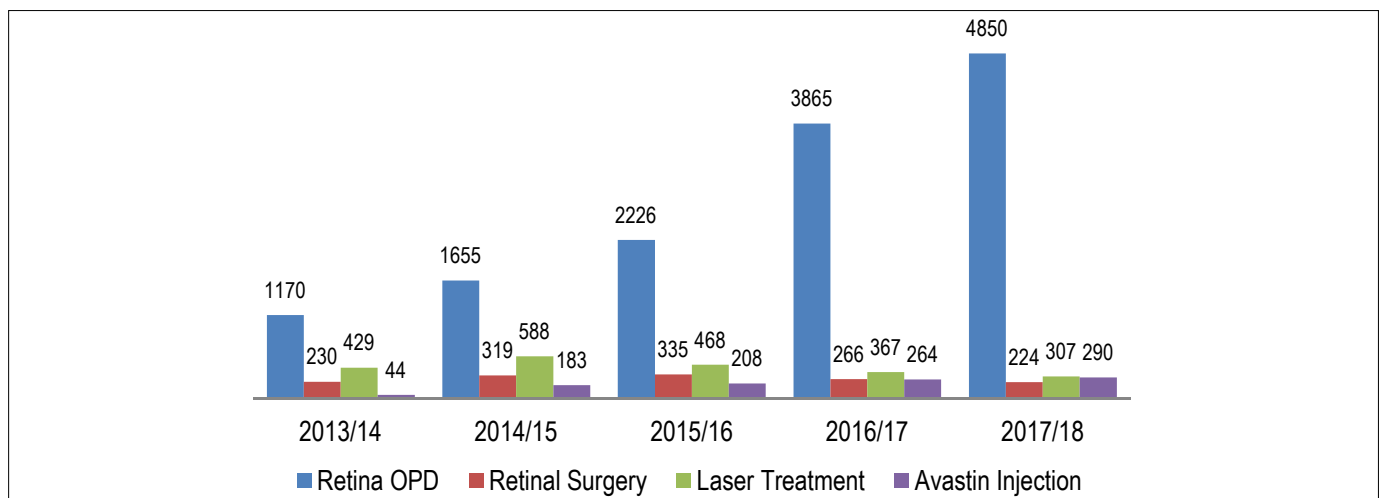


Vitreo-Retinal Service:

It is well established service headed by senior consultant Vitreo-Retinal Surgeon. All necessary equipments like OCT, USG, Fundus Photography, FFA & Green Laser are available, which add in diagnosing and treatment of retinal problems. It has also been established as a training center where currently two ophthalmologists are doing their fellowship in retina. In 2017/2018 retina departments has provided service to a total 4,950 Outpatients of which 821 underwent various retinal surgeries including vitreal injection. Out of total retina OPD patients 2312 Diabetic Retinopathy outpatients were diagnosed and treated. Patients not only from Chitwan and neighboring districts but also from neighboring county like India are provided with retinal service in this hospital. In this year, 3 diabetic retinopathy camps were conducted, were 131 patients with diabetes mellitus were screened and 15 patients were referred to this hospital for further treatment. Few percentages of patients are from India for the retina disease treatment.

Glaucoma Service:

A total 843 patients were diagnosed with glaucoma and 14 patients were done surgery in 2017/2018. Instruments like Goldman Perimetry, frequency Doubling Test (FDT), Optic Disc Photography and OCT which facilitates in diagnosing and treatment of glaucoma patient.

Low Vision Service:

This hospital is providing low vision services since last two years. All kinds of devices available in this hospital. Optical devices; non-optical and electronic devices which are much more significant for low-vision and visually impaired patients. Altogether 64 patients (Male: 38, Female: 26) with low vision were assessed. Special low vision devices were offered to 6patients. With the increase in the number of retina patients the need of low vision care is increasing.

Tele-Ophthalmology Service:

Bharatpur Eye Hospital started tele-ophthalmology service with aim to provide door to door appropriate eye care services to general public. Through this service base hospital is connected to ECCs and ophthalmic Assistants at ECCs can communicate with ophthalmologist at base hospital to confirm diagnosis so as to provide appropriate treatment to patients. This hospital has been strengthening the service, so that the community needy people can have easy access to the eye care service from Eye Care Center through base hospital. Tele-ophthalmology service has been started from Eye Care Center Salyantaar, Dhading and Eye Care Center Simorghad, Bara. It will be introduced to other Eye Care Centers soon.



Lab Service:

Bharatpur Eye Hospital has well equipped and facilitated laboratory services for patient undergoing ocular surgeries since 2012. Almost majority of all required laboratory investigations including culture are performed in the lab. A total of 5081 patients underwent different lab investigation in 2017/018.



OUTREACH ACTIVITIES:

Bharatpur Eye Hospital has provided service not only to hospital walking patients but also to patient in remote areas who do not have access to the hospital through the means of various outreach activities. In addition to the conduction of DST camps, cataract surgical camps, diabetic retinopathy camp and school screening program throughout the year, BEH has also been involved in awareness campaigns through training to FCHVs, Drug Retailers, School Teachers and Women Groups with the aim of reducing preventable blindness in the community.

RESEARCH

VIEW (Village Integrated Eye Workers Trial)

Since August 2017, SightLife is taking over the VIEW I activities, community randomized trial conduct by F.I. Proctor Foundation, USA from 2014-2017. Where we have 117 trained Female Community Health Volunteers (FCHVs) from nine and three VDCs of Nawalparasi and Chitwan districts respectively involved in detecting and treating corneal abrasions in their communities. SightLife founded in 1969 is the only non-profit global health organization solely focused on eliminating corneal blindness around the world through prevention programs, eye banking and corneal transplants. VIEW-II-Pilot Study is the second phase of VIEW study lunched in June 2018 by Francis I. Proctor Foundation, UCSF in collaboration with Seva Foundation and Bharatpur Eye Hospital. This study aims to determine whether a community based screening program is more effective than cataract camp approach, in detecting more cases of glaucoma, DR and AMD and also to determine whether a community health volunteer program increases the rate of cataract surgery compared to a no program. This pilot study is still undergoing.



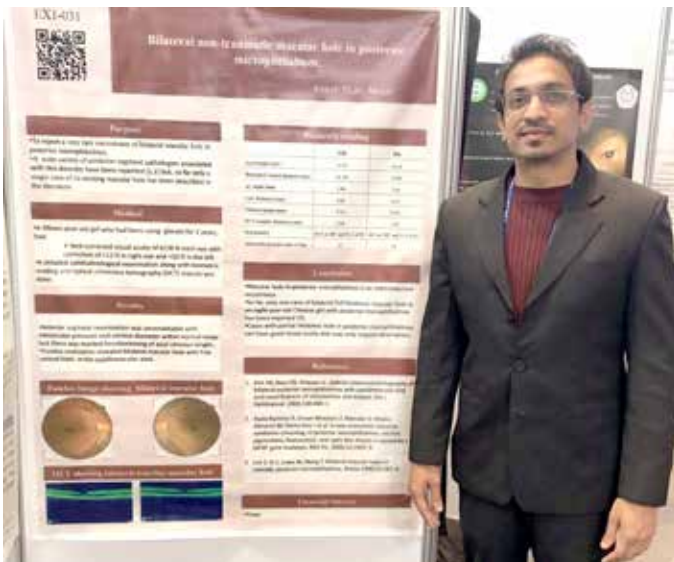

SUMMARY

In 2017/18 a total of 1,76,431 patients were served through Bharatpur Eye Hospital, its eye care centers and outreach activities. More female patients than males are found to be seeking the eye care services. Of the total patients 54% are females and 46% are males. 6,766 patients were provided major and minor surgical care which is almost 6 % of the total hospital patients and majority 64% were cataract surgeries. With the motive to provide more comprehensive and quality service this hospital has been able to establish new sub specialty services and upgraded the existing ones.

177 ocular surgeries were done in children that include 34 cataract surgeries and 15 squint surgeries in year 2017/18. 52 patients sight was restored who were having poor vision due to corneal opacity through corneal transplants and collected 8 corneas since the establishment of cornea collection center.

In 2017/18 almost 4% of the total patients were retina patients of which 821 of them received various retina surgeries including laser treatment and Avastin injection. Patient not only from Chitwan and neighboring districts but also from India come for their retina checkup and hospital has been developed as referral Centre for retina.

Outreach programs is one of the major component of hospital where we reach the unreached people and provide services through wide range of community based activities. This year a total of 24391 patients were examined through various outreach activities that includes DST camp, surgical camps, monthly clinics at health posts, DR camps and refraction camps. 1762 of sight restoring cataract surgeries were done through a camp which is 40% of total cataract surgeries done in 2017/18.

Screening was done in 66,690 schools going children from 155 schools both public and private in Chitwan, Nawalparasi and adjoining districts and provided glass to 1948 school children. Training was organized for 379 individuals those include school teachers, Female Community Health Volunteers (FCHVs) and women groups regarding basic eye health in order to create awareness on ocular problems in the community.

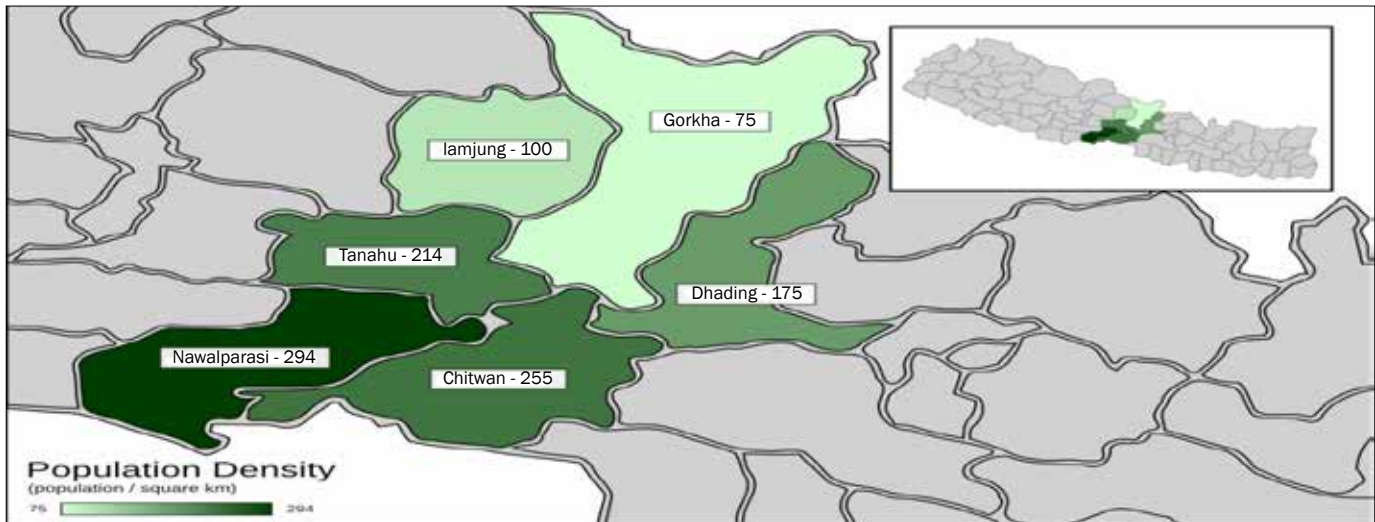

Case Study

Ms Jun Maya Shrestha, 53 years female, lives in Ratananagar municipality in Chitwan district. She lives in one hour walking distance from Ratananagar eye care center. She is literate and runs tailor shop for livelihood since many years. For one - two years she was having difficulties to see the near object & put thread into needle of sewing machine. Most of the time, she was having hard time to insert thread into the needle. She shared this problem to one of her neighbour who received the service from this eye care center. Due to lack of information of service availability; she could not visit for an eye examination.

Her near vision was tested at the Eye Care Center. She was further examined by trained ophthalmic assistant and diagnosed with Presbyopia. Her presenting VA was corrected with a pair of presbyopic eye glasses. After wearing a pair of glasses, she was delighted and paid thankful to in-charge and Bharatpur eye hospital, a partner of hospital of SEVA.
